'Make it shine' aim of school campaigners

A NEW COMMITTEE is so determined to build a school for children with special needs in the Holderness area its members have already decided on a name for the venture.

And even though at this stage not a brick has been laid, the school will be called "Make it shine" - a name which came from a competition by the children of Aldbrough Primary School.

The chair of the committee is Hazel Cockill of Aldbrough who has a son Leo with special needs who currently has to spend nearly four hours every day travelling to a school which caters for his needs.

This causes severe problems for Leo and these prompted Hazel to have the idea of a school in the Holderness area

and she soon discovered she was not alone in this desire as there were other parents in a similar situation.

Like Leo their children are having to travel long distances to be educated in line with their special needs at schools in Hull, Driffield and Goole.

The committee, which includes persons who want to support parents like Hazel, is looking to find and fund a school to serve children with special needs living in the coastal area from Spurn to Bridlington and also inland for any child who would benefit from such a school in terms of

travel time and distance. The aim then is to establish a Free School for about 70 pupils in the four to 18-year-age group and they already have the support of local MP Graham Stuart.

He has given the group advice on how to carry

the project forward and that requires them to have a plan in place by February 2013 in order to get government support.

Having set up a committee the next stage is to identify a current building that could be converted for their

particular requirements, or if necessary, a new building for which the land would need to be identified and purchased or donated.

Alongside this target is

the ever-present need of continued funding and to get things started a series of fund raising ventures have been organised.

The committee is appealing to anyone who may be able to help in any way and they especially urgently need a Patron who would be committed to the project and there is a pressing need to satisfy the building requirement.

The next two funding events are scheduled for Wednesday, May 9 at 10am in the Aldbrough Youth Club where there will be a: "Trip Down Memory Lane."

The second event is an auction night at the Wrygarth Inn at Great Hatfield scheduled for Saturday, May 16 and there have already been a number of exciting lots donated including signed
