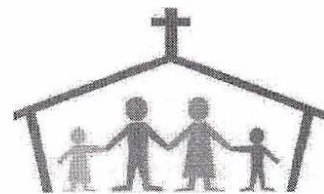

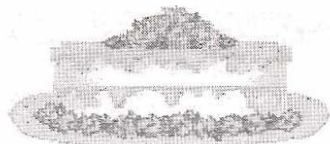

She had recreated the skeins of wool that would have been for sales. Even a old fashioned cash register had been made.
