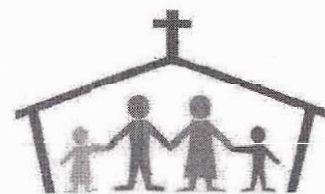

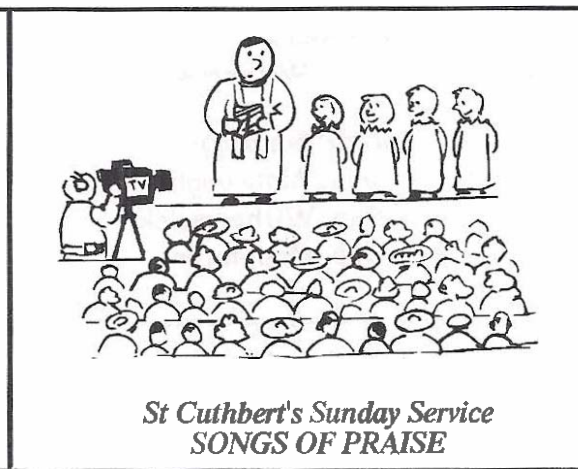
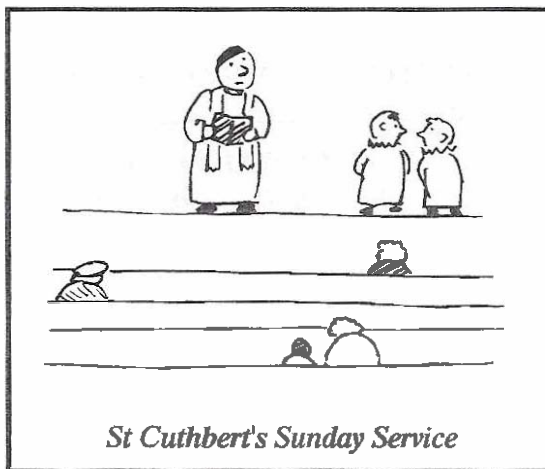
## Aldbrough WI .
