- 3 – Hog Roast – 60 people so far coming, this is optimistic but still need to push ticket sales.

Parking on site will only be available for bands, otherwise the gate to the site will be shut.
The hog-roast people will be in a gazebo near the gate. The vegetarian food will be in a separate gazebo also near the gate. The gazebos are stored in Voase's chapel.
Rachael Wile will have a stall selling sweets and candyfloss.
The stage and toilets will be put in place on Friday. Then we will put up the gazebos and bunting on Saturday morning. We will need help on the Saturday morning.
Mike will camp on the site on Saturday night/Sunday morning to keep an eye on any stuff left on the site. We will also need help on Sunday morning to clear up.
The stage will have its back to the road.
A first aid area will be provided.
No salad will be provided but people are welcome to bring their own.
We need to ask if it is worth taking out a one-off insurance for <200 people.
We definitely have 2 bands, maybe more still to confirm.
Nikki will ring to confirm details with the Hog Roast people re times etc.
We have 60m of 'fairy' lights and we will also have floodlights near the entrance.
