Withernwick Poores Land Charity

Pat Oxley one of the trustees of the Withernwick Poores Land Charity attended the meeting and kindly gave the following update:- Within the next 4 weeks the existing Village Hall is to be demolished completely, this is being paid for by Eon.. The site is to be grassed and a gate is to be erected at the entrance. There will be access through for pedestrians/prams. The village hall site is then to be maintained by James Witty he is to cut the hedges back to 3ft. Mr Oxley reported that the land is available in the future for the building of a new village hall subject to the necessary planning applications etc
The Poores Charity are going to write to Eon/Enigikor to ask for a donation to their Registered Charity.

Bank Account & Finances:

Sue Voase gave everyone in attendance a copy of the breakdown of income & expenditure.

Village Questionnaire:

Mike Soper said so far we have received good positive results in connection with the proposed building of a new village hall

Association Constitution document:

Charles Sharp has taken over the preparation of this document, as he wasn't at the meeting this item is going to be discussed at the February meeting.

Planned Events:

Race Night: John Mann has been in contact with the Landlord of the Gardeners Arms at Coniston. The Banqueting Room is available free of charge with the bar in the room open if we have 60 people plus. Date to be confirmed either Saturday 10th or Saturday 17th April 2010 Tickets £8. Val Harrison is to have a word with Pearson Coaches to obtain a price for a coach from the Falcon Inn.

Xmas Party: Easter Egg Hunt – Mike Soper is to speak to Dawn in connection with this event. It was agreed that Easter Monday would be a good day to hold it.

Village Fete: 6th June 2010 – Pat Oxley said there was a possibility that the Fete could be held on the old Village Hall site.

A list is being compiled of stalls/attractions etc:- The following were mentioned:- Fire Engine, Hornsea Life Boat, Dog Show (Smaller than last year), Local Dance Class, Army Cadets, Fairtrade (co-op), Mr Moos Ice-cream, BBQ, Cookery demonstration, Hoop-la, Coconut Shy etc etc

Julia Beevers said we could do to buy our own Coconut Shy, Hoop-la rather than relying on other peoples. Mike Soper is going to look into this. Sue Voase is to contact Bonus Electrical in connection with a Tea Urn and Pets R Wright in connection with water carriers.

A list of charities proposed to benefit from the Fete were mentioned:- Hornsea Inshore Rescue, Alzheimer's, St Albans Church, Scope etc It is to be agreed by the committee at the next meeting of our chosen charities.

Any Other Business:

Jo Arnett suggested a Jamie Oliver at Home party, whereby 15% of the profits on the night would go to the Association. It was agreed to hold a party on Tuesday 2nd March 8pm at the Falcon Inn.

Joanne Arnett announced that there is to be a meeting held in the Sunday School Rooms on Wednesday 10th February 1.30pm for a 2pm Start, it will last approximately 2 hours and it is to discuss Village Hall Community networks within the area. A notice about the meeting is in the window of Blondies Hair Salon explaining what the meeting is about. A number of the committee members have offered to attend the meeting.

Carol Wilkie suggested a BBQ and Band on the Playing Field the night before the Village Fete (5th June) Sue Voase is to have another word with Mathew Marshall in connection with the cost of the band.

Helen Drury suggested a Weight Loss Competition to be held in the Sunday School Rooms it would be a 12 week course costing £39 per person each weekly session would last 1 hour. 20-35 people would need to attend in order for the Association to benefit from £500, there would be prize money at the end of the course totaling £600 shared between first, second and third who have lost the biggest percentage of weight over the 12 week period. It was agreed to hold the competition in the Sunday School Rooms on a Thursday evening 6.30pm till 7.30pm starting on Thursday 25th February 2010. Posters are to be circulated together with leaflets. Adverts will be put in the local press and Radio Humberside
