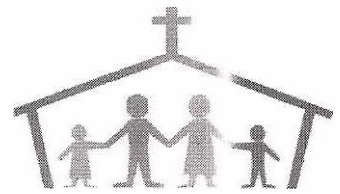

One reason is insurance premiums which have risen again this year. Each Parish Church needs to find well over £2000 for cover, and of course there are the ongoing repairs to these lovely ancient buildings.

15 of us made a return trip to Roger Simpson and St Michael le Belfry, York, after Festival 2011. We were well fed at tea and enjoyed a somewhat different evening service in Church: lots of singing and standing with over 100 young people there along with many others in the congregation.

In September I hope to lead **Sermons in Stone**, which has the approval of all three Church Councils. I hope many of you will advantage of this as we seek to encourage the use of our church buildings in telling others of God.

**ALDBROUGH LADIES' FELLOWSHIP** Our meeting held on Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> July was attended by nine ladies. Sheila Middleton took the Chair and after the business was attended to, we were entertained by Sue Pallister, the **General Manager of HERIB** (Hull and East Riding Institute for the Blind). She told us of the early days in 1864 when Mr Moon who had invented a kind of raised writing taught blind people to read. This was before Louis Braille had invented his braille method. Mr Moon contacted the Alderman of Hull and together they formed The Blind Institute, shortly afterwards Louise Braille brought out his own method to help blind people to read and write and the Hull Blind Institute adopted his method. During the war they lost premises through the bombing of Hull. They had premises in Kingston Square at this time and all that was left after the bombing was the stone arch over the entrance inscribed 'Hull and East Riding Institute for the Blind'. Today a modern building stands on the site but the arch still remains, proudly bearing the name. The Reckitt family supported them in the early days and presented to them the lease of Rockcliffe House in 1920. Sue said the lease document, which dates from the time the house was owned by the Reckitt family in 1834 is on thick vellum parchment and is a fascinating history of the ownership of the house. Nowadays they have Day Centres, with mini buses which bring people in from the surrounding areas. They will also come out to your area with one of their buses which is equipped with a kitchen, computer, information and they will help you with whatever you need. They will help you fill in forms etc. At the Resource Centre on Beverley Road, where items are made and displayed you can go and "try before you buy". Such items as speaking microwaves, clocks, wristwatches, appointment reminders, alarms so you do not overflow a cup, chairs, brushes, mats, baskets from shopping ones, bicycle baskets, fishermen's baskets, and all sizes from those used in the home to those used in theatres and schools for storage. There were so many items it was unbelievable. and did you know a white stick lets others know you are blind but if it has red stripes on it then it means you are blind and deaf. Useful information to know! We all enjoyed the afternoon which ended with a raffle (plenty of prizes) and tea and cake. Our next meeting will be 14th September when we are having a photograph competition. *Norma Potter*
