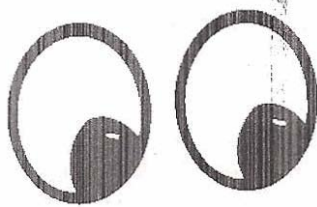

**News from John Witty:** had a drive up to RSPB Saltholme wildlife reserve and discovery park Teesside. We had a great day out Sunday lunch very good and the best coffee I have had. About the place, they have one of the largest colonies of common terns and dragonfly path, on a nice summer day you will see lots of them. On Saltholme pools in winter months short eared owls hunting, lapwings nest at the place and lots of ground nesting birds skylarks come, buntings etc. A bit more about the reserve, have a small flock of Shetland sheep to keep the grass down also and some highland cattle so a good place. It used to belong to the ICI factory, used for chemicals and all sorts of stuff. You name it they made it would believe down the road a big petro chemicals works and Port Clarence. The centre is 3 years old now all brand new and getting better all the time: been left to wildlife. It's a long drive 200 round trip but worth the drive plus as always with RSPB, friendly staff. I know some them on my face book friends so I say have a drive up there. You will really like the place: good food and a fabulous place. Lastly at Bempton, we have an alpine swift been with us for a week now plenty of puffin this year more than I have seen for years have been seen with lots of sand eels in their beaks. I am very pleased about that. I have been doing wildlife guided walks and talking to them all about the wildlife at Bempton. Regards to all my readers.
