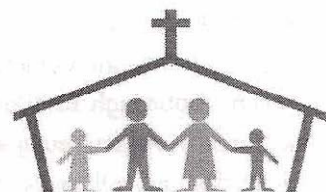

ALDBROUGH W.I.

At the May meeting, President Mrs. K. Moore welcomed 21 members; there were 5 apologies of absence. Minutes of the April, meeting were agreed and signed. Members were reminded of the Jubilee Lunch on 20 June to be held at the Leven Sports Hall. Members wishing to attend to see the secretary. The WI president has a copy of the new courses for Denman College available for members to view. Members were asked to complete a survey from national re the WI centenary AGM to be held in 2015. Questionnaire to be returned to the August meeting. Aldbrough WI representative at the East Riding Federation Meeting at Beverley held in April was Janice Gill, who gave comprehensive feedback. The WI group rally was announced and members were encouraged to enter the craft classes and attend the rally on 7 June at Bilton.

Following the business part of the meeting The President welcome Lisa, Neil and Sasha from the Humberside Wildlife Rescue. They gave a very interesting overview of the work they do, how they train members to become members of the rescue service. They told of some of the rescues they have been involved in, which highlighted the time and commitment that is required. They told of pup seals only a few days old apparently abandoned by their mothers on the beach had in fact been left in safety while mothers returned to sea to feed. This highlighted the importance of not moving apparently abandoned pups, but to contact the authorities and allow them to deal with the situation. Also Neil pointed out that often stranded marine life carry harmful bacteria that could result in illness in humans and that in fact some of the diseases they carry are lethal to dogs.

A Vote of thanks was given by Tina Longstaff.

Withernwick Ladies Group

The ladies group AGM was held in the Methodist room, Withernwick on Wednesday February 1st. Twelve members attended. Last years officers were re-elected, Mrs Anne Wood - Chair, Mrs Christine Humphrey - Secretary, Mrs Pat Beddard - Treasurer. The Misses Ann and Maureen Woollin agreed to act as speaker finder for the coming year.

After a resume of the last years numerous events members received a copy of accounts and Treasurers report.

Our speaker finders outlined a varied programme for the following few months in spite of the uncertainty of the future venue.

February 7th

Members met for an evening meal at The Falcon, Withernwick, taking the opportunity to present a cheque for £100 to Amy Sherman, a donation to the charity Scope.

March 7th

After the usual items of business members enjoyed listening to Izzy Moulds talking about her interest in fashion and design. Izzy is attending Bishop Burton College, studying the subject and displayed an extensive and varied amount of items which she had made.

Members admired cushion, bags, notice boards, jackets, skirts, even a wedding dress, most made from re-cycled materials.

April 4th

This was the last meeting to be held in the Methodist Room and was conducted by the Misses Ann and Maureen Woollin in the absence of other officers. Mrs Dunn thanked members for the donation to Scope and announced that Amy, her granddaughter, had run 100 metres in the Olympic stadium in 29.4 seconds and that one of our members had won the raffle to guess the time taken, organised at The Falcon. Members agreed to send a bouquet of flowers to Mrs Joan Gibson on the occasion of her 90th birthday. Mrs Doreen Shuttleworth then entertained members with an account of her birthday treat of a wonderful flight in a hot air balloon.

May 2nd

This was the first meeting held at St Albans Church, Withernwick following the recent sale of the Methodist Room. 16 members and guests attended. Items of business included details of the next meeting in June when we are to visit the Stained Glass Centre near Filey. Mrs Humphrey reported that the Parish Council are happy with our proposal to plant two trees near the burial ground in memory of Mrs Norah Spencer and to commemorate the Queen's Diamond Jubilee. The Village Committee will pay for the trees and the the Ladies Group will meet the cost of appropriate plaques. Mr Ian Carmichael from the Beverley Barge Preservation Society then took members through the history of the Barge Society with particular reference to the barge Syntan which is moored on Beverley Beck. The barge was built in 1948 at Paull for Hodgsons and gave many years of service delivering very varied goods to and from places like Sheffield and Tadcaster.

Laid up at Doncaster power station in 1980 it was vandalised and then rescued by the newly formed society in 2001. Over recent years it has been restored and is now used as an educational and pleasure vessel and can be hired for meetings, childrens parties and trips for 12 on the River Hull and the Humber.

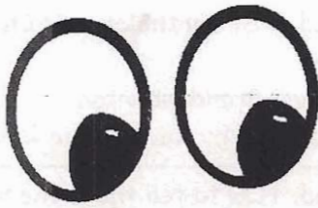

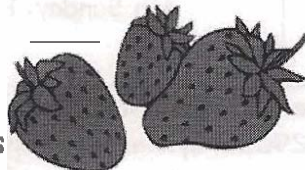

I have a pair of blackbirds near me very busy feeding their new family and doing ok with them, even though we have one or two cats near me which will catch them. At home in the garden I have a cat deterrent which does not harm them, just moves them off. At the cliffs the first gannet chick has arrived. It now will be fed for about 90 days then it's on its own, leaves the nest, lands on the sea, can't fly as it is far too heavy so it can't feed till it loses weight. All the other sea birds are laying their eggs. The skylarks are singing very nice. John
