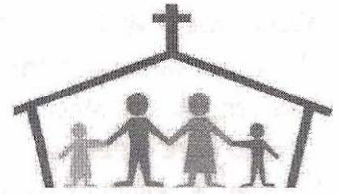

Any ladies interested in joining us please contact either Kath Moore or Liz Rothery or just come and join us, a warm welcome awaits you.

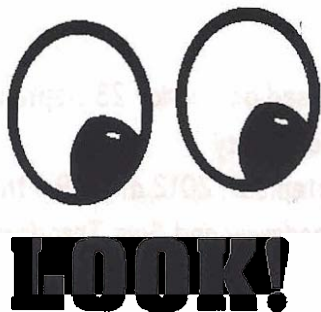
News From John Witty

As i said in last month i would write a bit more about Orkney isle, the st Magnus cathedral, it was founded in the year 1137 by earl rognvald-kali, the nephew of the martyred earl Magnus. It is dedicated mangos and is remains the cathedral was part of the Norwegian arch- diocese of Trondheim for most of the reformation Years. Orkney became part of the kingdom of Scotland in the years 1468, and 1486 was given into care of the people of Kirkwall by the Scottish king James III. Today the cathedral remains the property of the people of Orkney. The Orkney island council spends more then £120,000 a year running the cathedral, and other large sums of money are spent on major repairs as they are needed. They have a 100,000 victors a year, it is suggested the each visitor might donate £1-00 towards the upkeep of this very old and full history. To end with, my very best friend passed away last month leslie steele's mother and father lived in Withernwick and was my best friend since i was about 5 years old.
