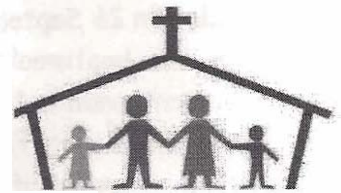

The latest meeting of the Aldbrough WI was held in Methodist Chapel School room on 6th August.

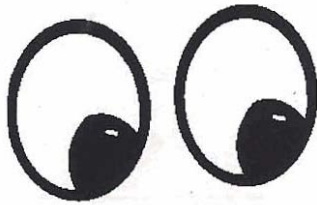

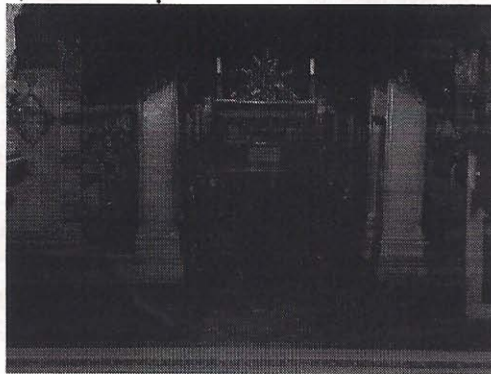

News from John Witty: Part 1 of my holidays to Dornoch in Scotland on the east coast, 200 miles from John O Groats. Went to Shin Falls where there is free fishing brown trout and salmon. Osprey on the nests, I saw the young had flown and gone to their winter quarters in Africa. The parents will go in Sept and return to the same nest site; also buzzard about. In the Dornoch Bay, eider ducks seen all year round - the male has white and black markings, the female is more like the mallard duck markings, also loads of divers: red throated and black throated about. They are all the time in the sheltered bay so I had a walk down to have a look at them - good to see so many wild birds in one place, plus down the coast large nestings of fulmars far more than we have at Bempton Cliffs. We had a day out at Ullapool on the shores of Loch Broom a lovely place, full of wild life, then another day out though the wild area of north Scotland the Kyle of Tonge. It is golden eagle area but sadly did not see one. Part 2 is about the day out the Orkney Isle and Kirkwall - a fabulous place for wild life. Regards, God bless you all.
